MISSION


To proclaim Jesus Christ and serve the Church and individuals in remote and isolated areas of Northern Canada.

Throughout 2023, On Eagle's Wings was pleased to run six in-person **Bible Camps**, while simultaneously dodging the worst wildfire season in recent history.

Our team of dedicated volunteers also prepared **475 backpacks** for our **Bible Camp in a Bag** ministry which were distributed across 20 communities in 3 Provinces and all 3 Territories.

Staff and volunteers also began training in **Caring for the Wounded Heart** as response to requests from communities to offer support in the areas of trauma, healing and mental health.








Financial Report

More bills were paid directly from our US account resulting in less currency exchanges and lower fees.



In 2021, we began receiving repeated requests to help northern communities in address their trauma & mental health crisis. We started praying for suitable resources.






THE DISCOVERY
