As volunteers travel through communities on their way to serve, they often find themselves building meaningful connections. Listening to stories, making new friends, or lending a hand like preparing meals at a local soup kitchen are just a few ways these bonds are formed along the journey. Their service goes beyond leading Bible Camp or healing groups. Building Faith and Fun

Volunteering at Bible Camp begins long before a team arrives in a community. It starts with preparation, completing screening, police checks, meetings, praying together, and helping with fundraising. Teams pack supplies and travel far and wide to reach communities by plane, ice roads, and car.



Camp days start early in the morning with snack preparation, like baking fresh bread, cookies, or a cake as a special treat for the kids. The volunteers also prepare crafts and the hosting space. The teams set aside time for prayer and reflection before children come to Bible Camp. Volunteers spend their days leading games, sharing Bible stories, and creating a fun and welcoming space where children feel loved and valued.

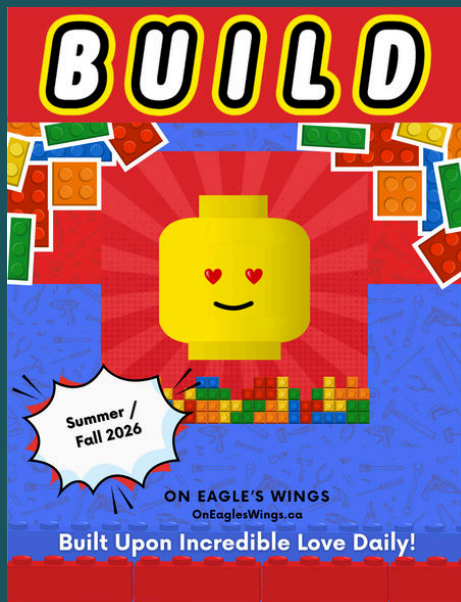
